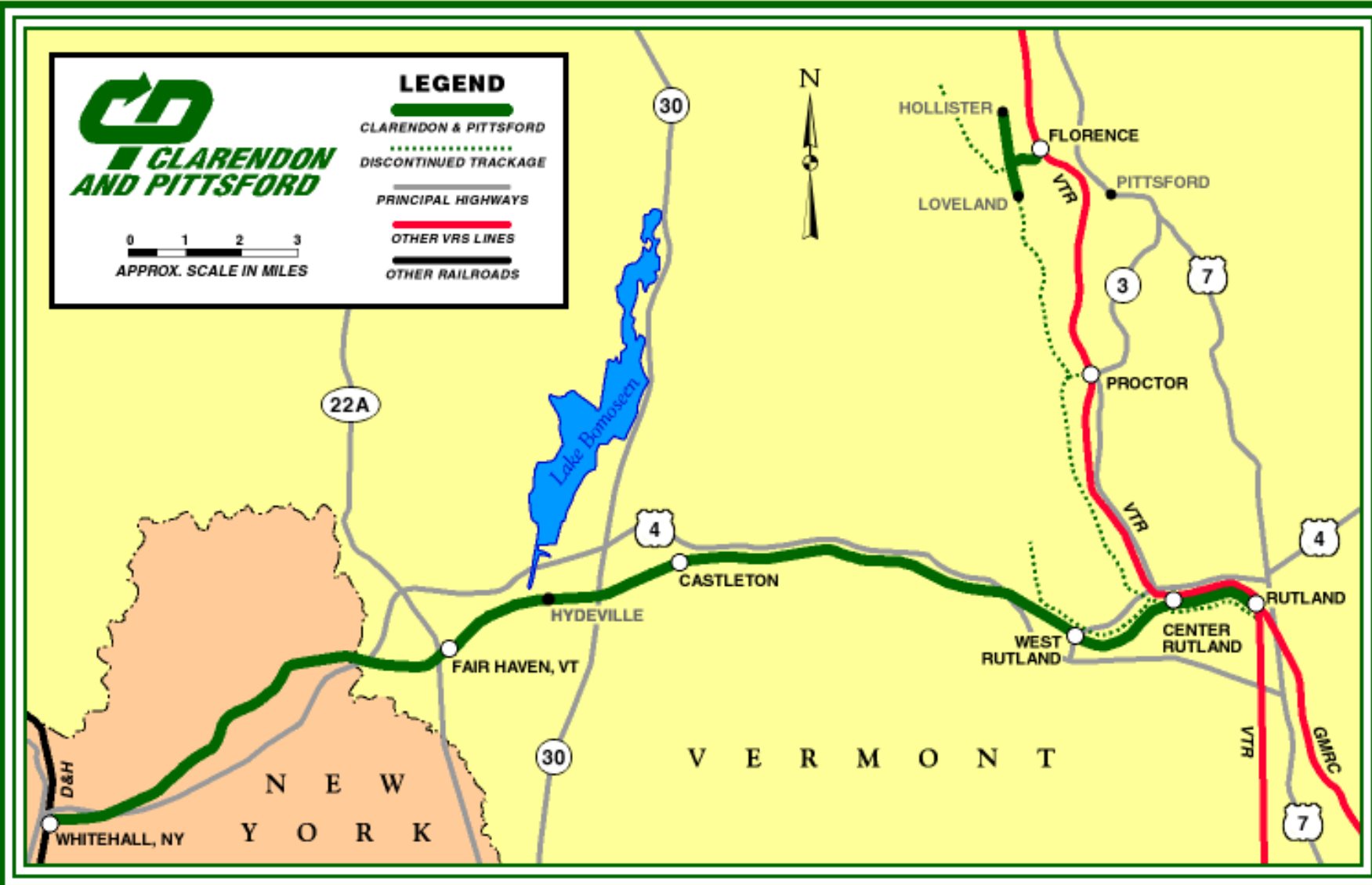

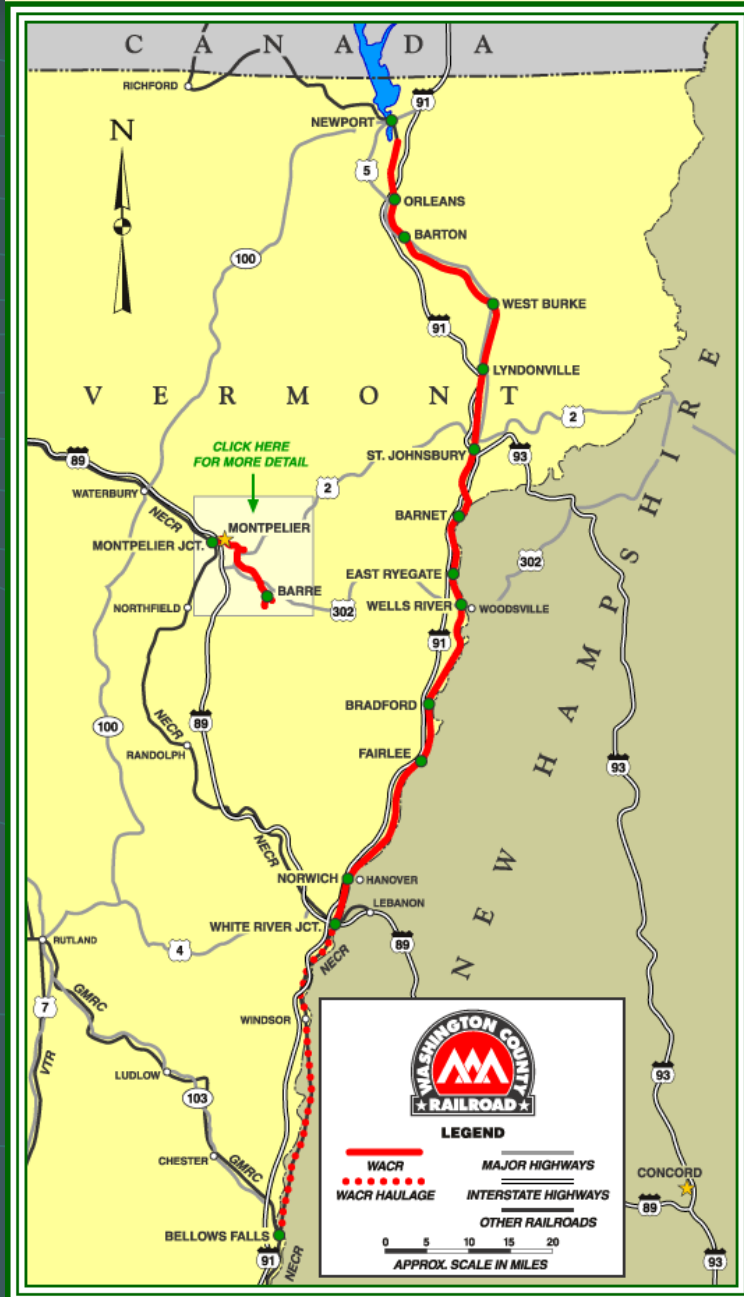

CLARENDON AND PITTSFORD RR MAP

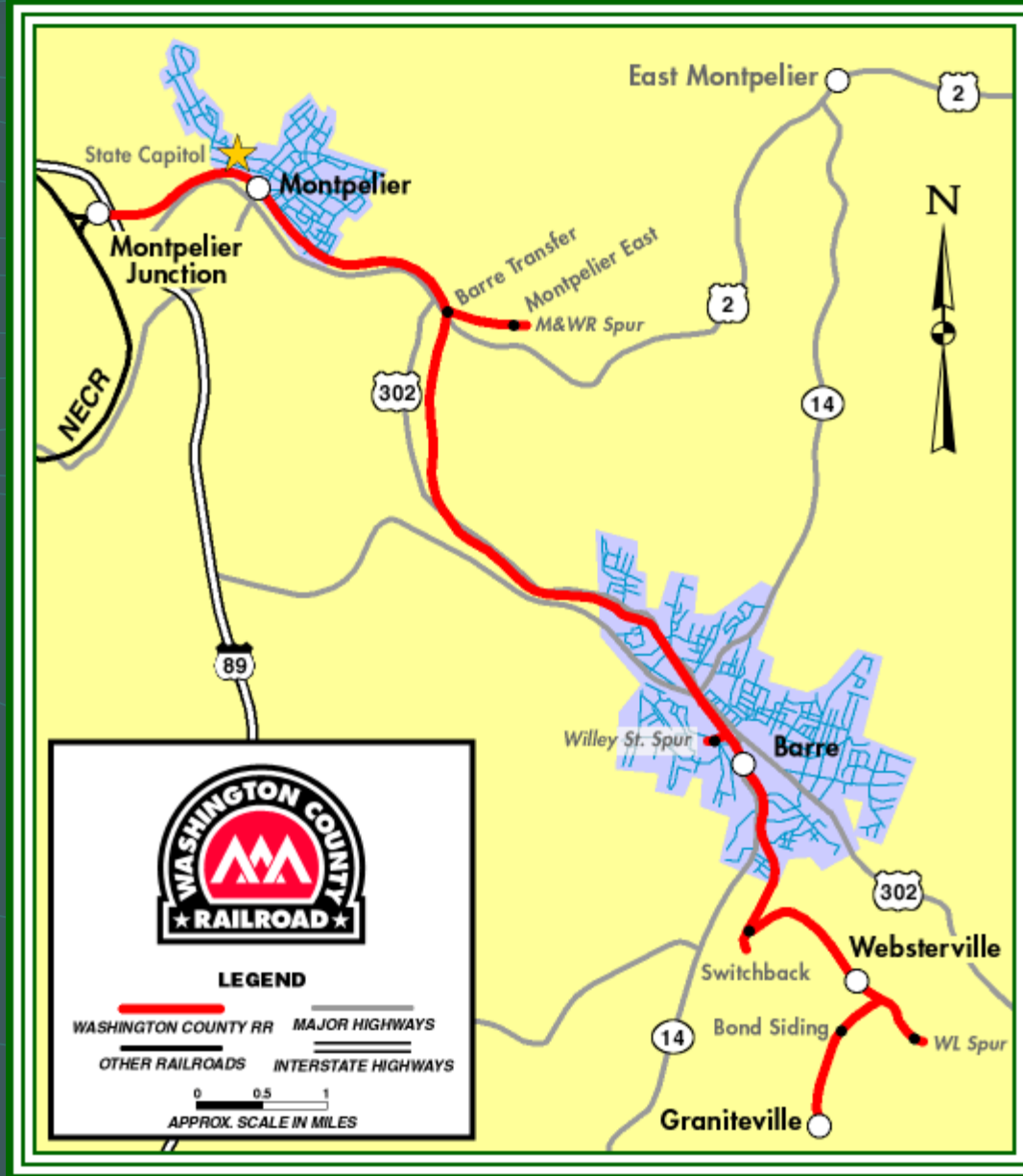


WASHINGTON COUNTY RR MAP

SAFETY

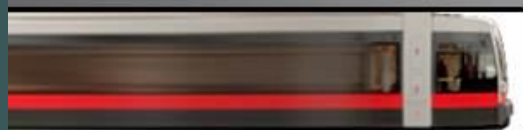

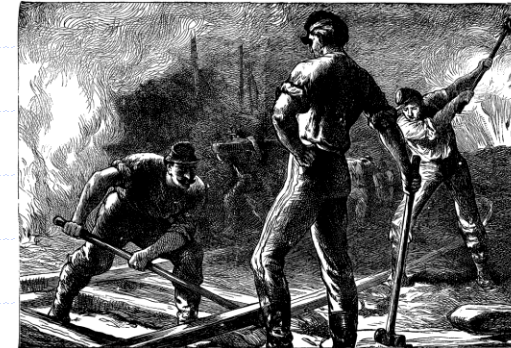

VRS Roadway Worker On-Track Safety Program

- ◆ Is designed to:
 - Protect roadway workers from being struck by moving locomotives, cars and roadway maintenance machines.
 - Prevent Accidents and Casualties caused by collisions between roadway maintenance machines and moving locomotives, cars and/or other maintenance machines.
 - Ensure roadway workers have a safe working environment.
 - Prevent accidents and casualties caused by operation of on-track roadway maintenance machines and hi-rail vehicles.



PRIVATE CONTRACTORS



- Private contractors whose operations may affect the safe movement of trains (within 25 feet of track)
 - Must Not Be Allowed To Foul The Tracks Unless:
 - They Have Been trained in the On-Track Safety Procedures, AND
 - Must have a qualified VRS employee assigned to protect work locations.

PRIVATE CONTRACTORS

- The qualified employee must:
 - Secure proper flagging equipment,
 - Ensure that tracks are not fouled without permission. Each day the employee must determine who is in charge of the workers and hold a job briefing,
 - When workers request permission to foul a track the employee assigned to protect the work location must contact the Dispatcher (or other Roadway worker in charge of the track) to secure protection.

PRIVATE CONTRACTORS

- If workers fail to comply with instructions, the employee must make an immediate report to the Roadway Worker in charge of the track,
- If an event occurs that would interfere with the safe passage of trains, the employee must take immediate action to stop trains by radio, both to trains and the Dispatcher. If protection cannot be immediately ensured, flag protection must be immediately provided.
